Highland Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant Biosolids Management

We invite you to attend an upcoming meeting to review, discuss and provide feedback on the analysis of biosolids management alternatives being considered for the Highland Creek Wastewater Treatment Plant (HCTP). The alternatives include: 1) new fluidized bed incinerators, 2) a new truck loading facility to enable a biosolids haulage program for off-site land application or disposal, or 3) a new pelletizer facility to dry the biosolids, including a new truck loading facility for haulage of pellets offsite.

A presentation about the evaluation of options will take place at 7:00 p.m.

Overview

Currently, biosolids are managed at the HCTP using two multiple hearth incinerators. As this equipment is nearing the end of its service life, a management approach is required to provide long term reliability. This Class EA was initiated to evaluate alternatives and identify the best solution for the HCTP.

The first PIC was held on June 16, 2014 to introduce the study approach and background. At the second Public Information Centre, on April 9, 2015, information was presented on the short-list of biosolids management alternatives, and the proposed health, environmental, social and economic factors to be considered in selecting the best solution for the HCTP.

At this third and final PIC for the study, the project team will present the the analysis of the available information and the findings that will be forwarded to City Council.
