Collisions

- There was 185 motor vehicle collisions during the month of April (zero fatalities).
- Notable hotspots include; the area of Kingston Rd/Lawrence Ave E, Lawrence Ave E/Markham Rd, Markham Rd/Ellesmere Rd, Eglinton Ave E., Lawrence Ave E/ McCowan Rd, and the area of the Scarborough Town Centre.
- These hotspots are similar to March 2022.
- Events occurred most often between 11:00 and 21:00, with no notable day of week trend.
- As the weather continues to warm up, we urge drivers to be mindful of increased pedestrian traffic.



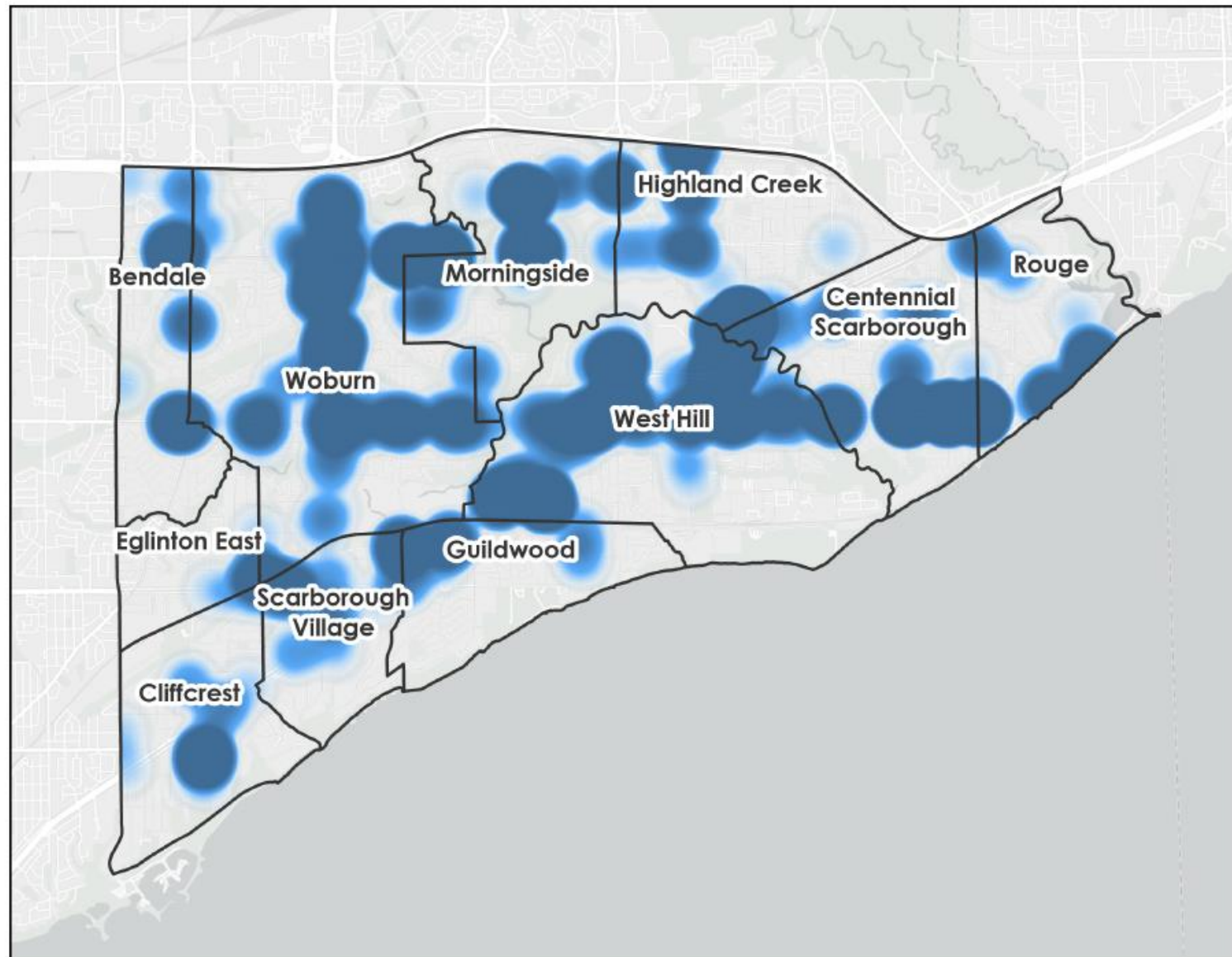
43 Division Collisions April 2022

Enforcement

- There was notable enforcement along Lawrence Ave E, Ellesmere Rd, Markham Rd, and Kingston Rd.
- The majority of tickets were issued during the morning and afternoon rush hours (08:00-11:00/15:00-18:00).
- Speeding tickets account for 36% of all tickets issued.
- The Toronto Police Service effectively executed a city-wide speeding enforcement campaign between April 11th to April 18th.

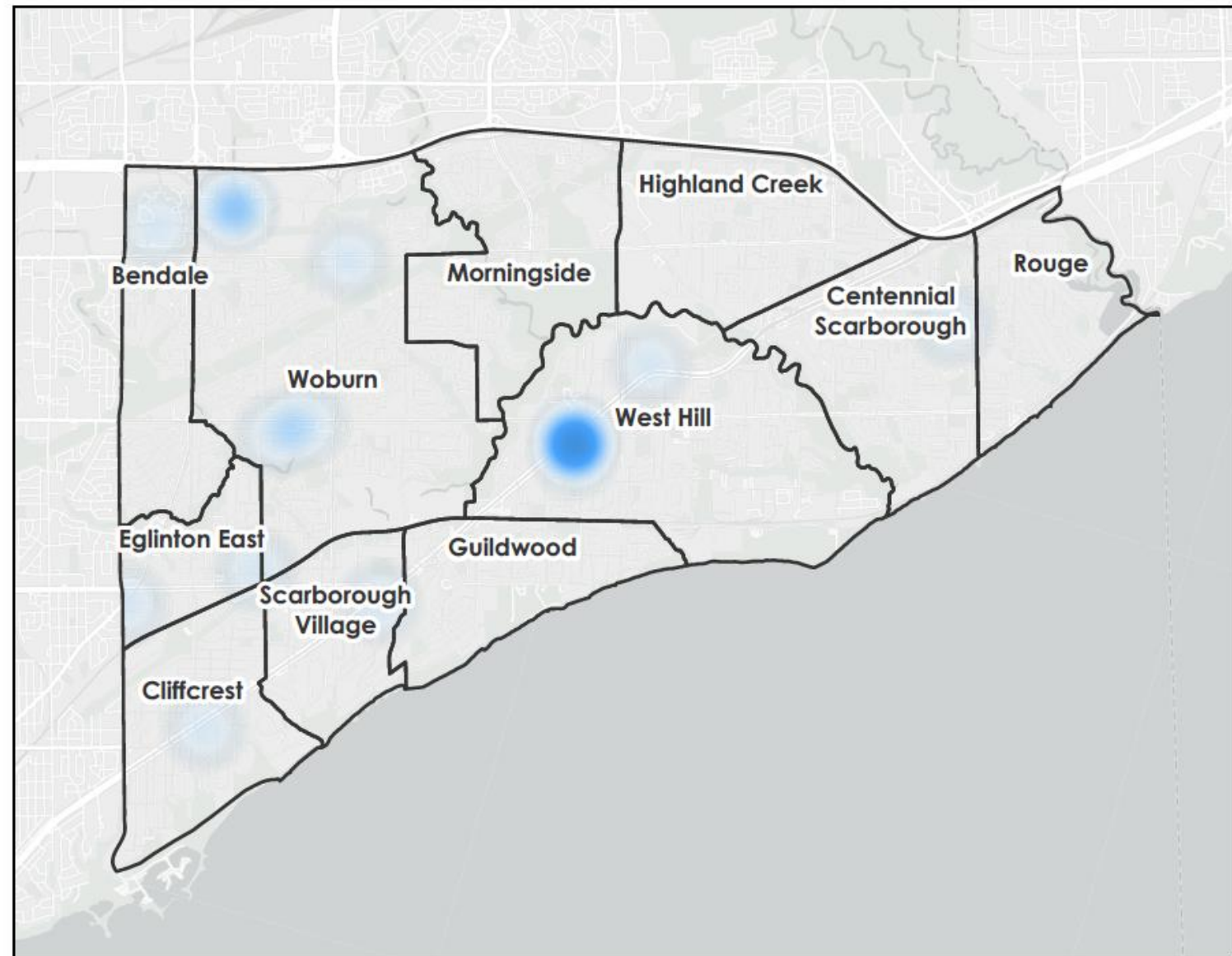
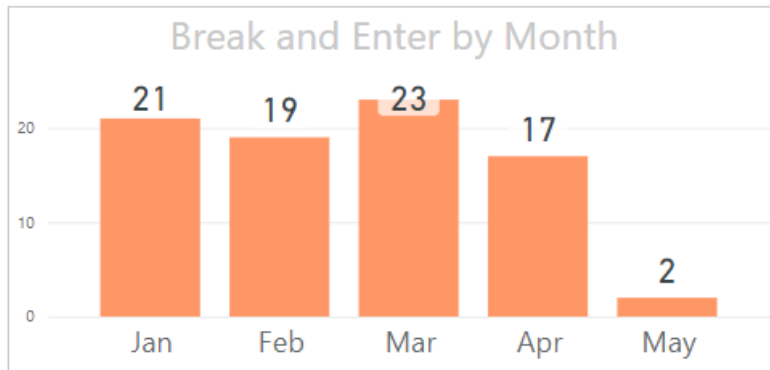
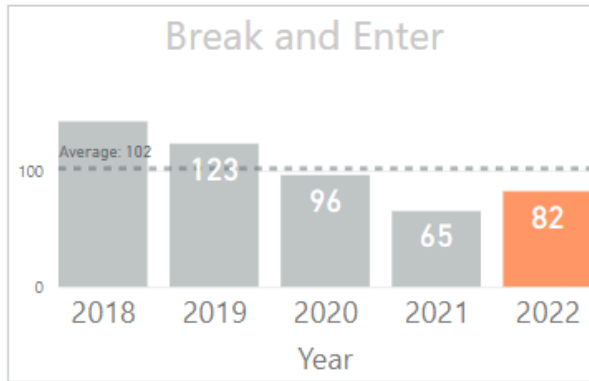

- There was a notable hotspot in the area of Kingston Rd/Poplar Rd (West Hill).
- 71% of Break and Enters were into commercial premises.
- The majority of commercial entries were into restaurants and electronics retailers.

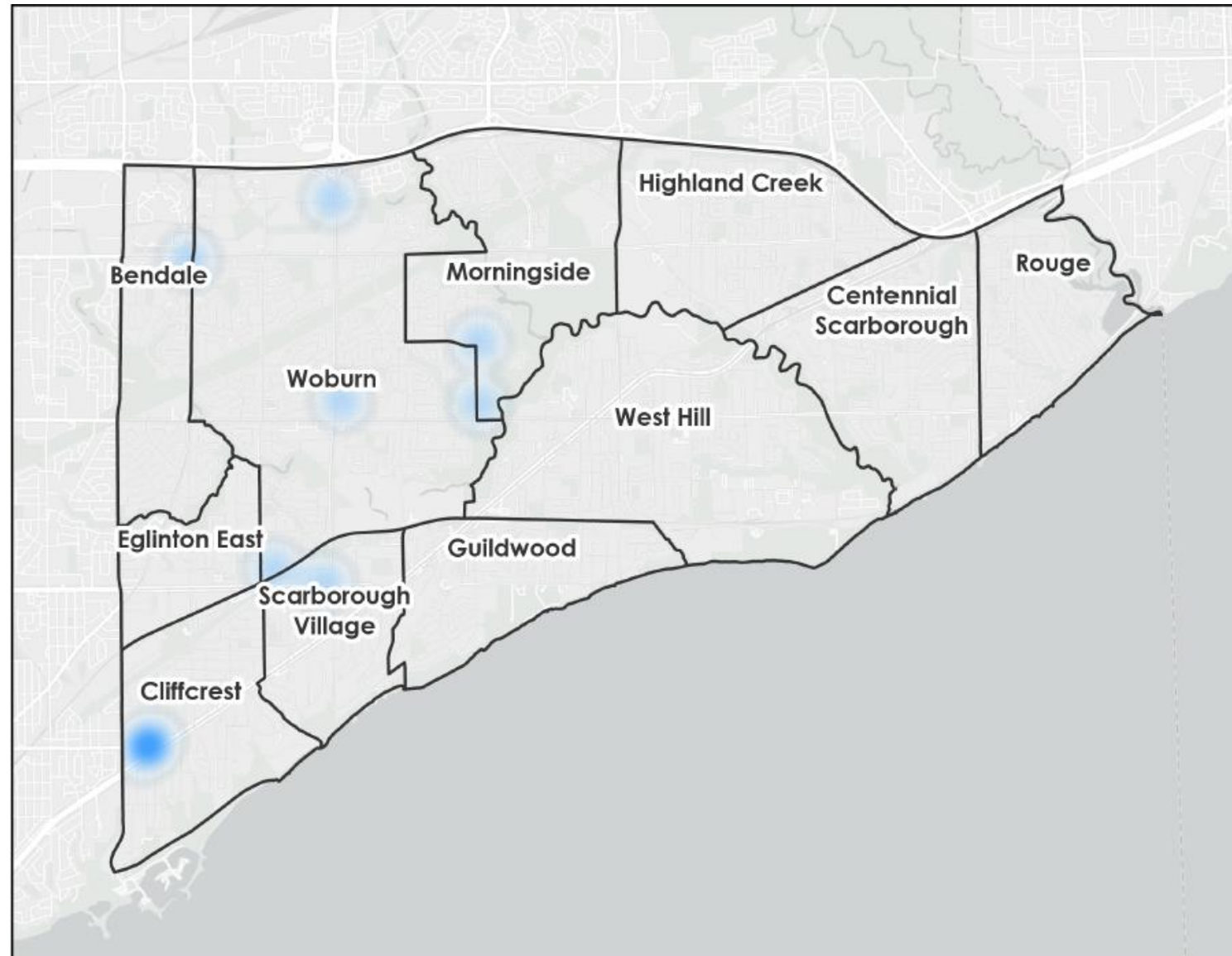
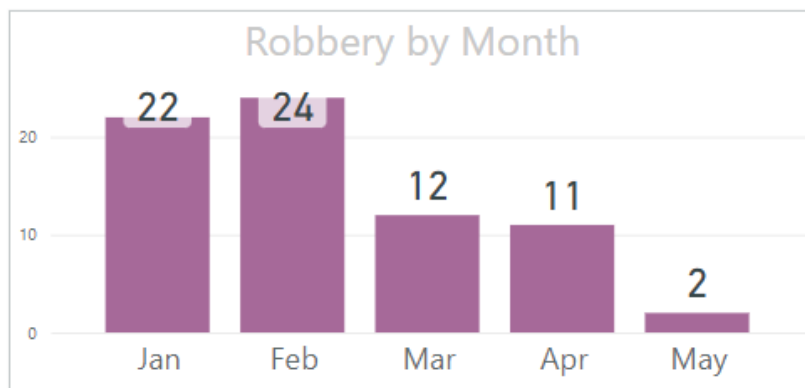
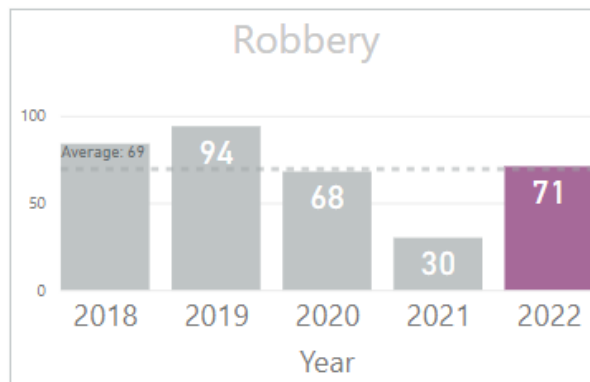

Robberies

- There was a notable hotspot in the area of Kingston Rd/St Clair Ave E (Cliffcrest), as well as clusters along Eglinton Ave E (Scarborough Village) and Orton Park Rd (Morningside).
- The majority of robberies occurred during the late afternoon and evening hours.
- 78% of occurrences involved perpetrators who were unknown to the victim.
- There was a notable series of vehicle jackings throughout the Scarborough divisions. An arrest has been made.

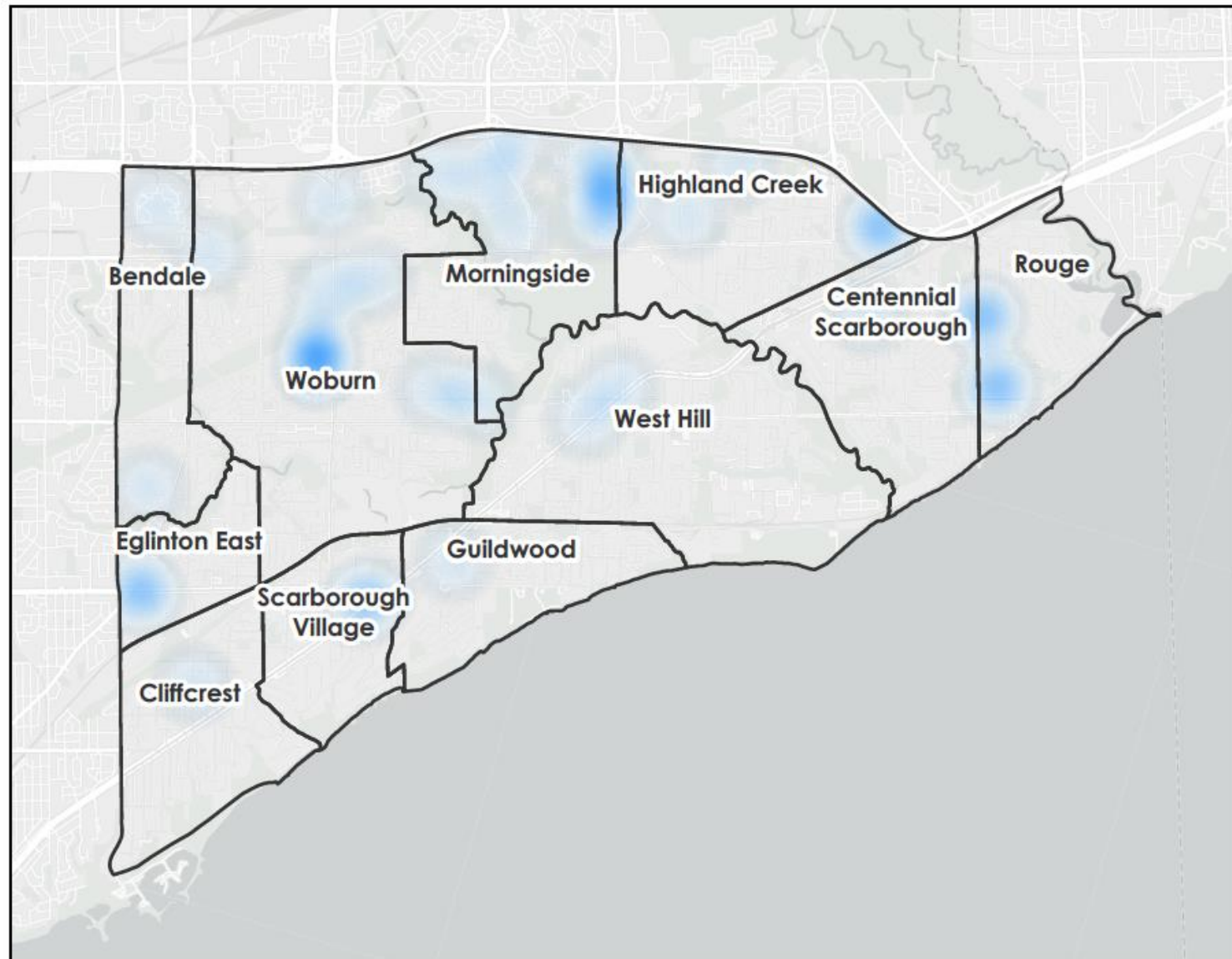
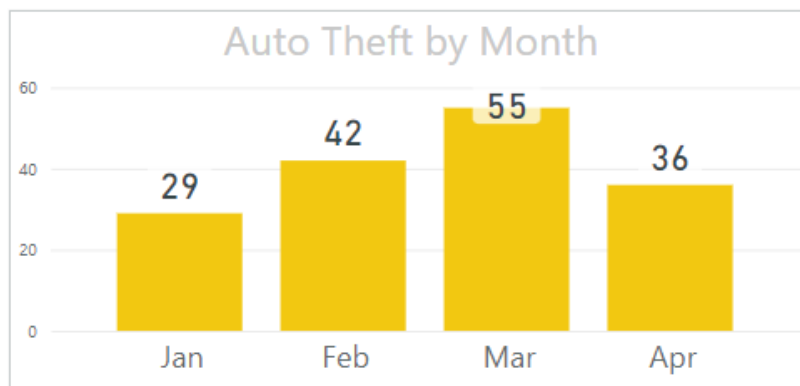
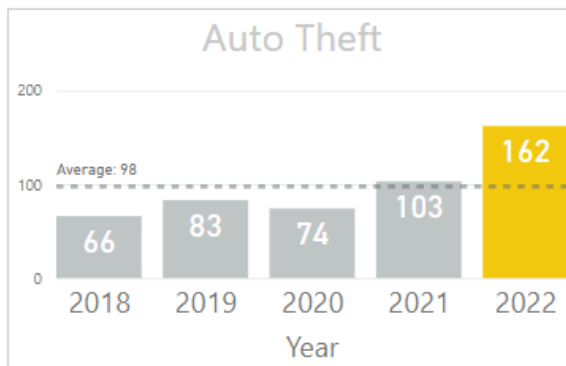

Auto Theft

- Occurrences were located sporadically throughout the division, with clusters in Morningside, Woburn, and Eglinton East.
- Warm-up thefts continued at a decreased rate, accounting for 19% of the monthly total.
 - Delivery vehicles left running and unlocked have been targeted more heavily.
 - We continue to urge residents to *never* leave their vehicle unattended while warming.

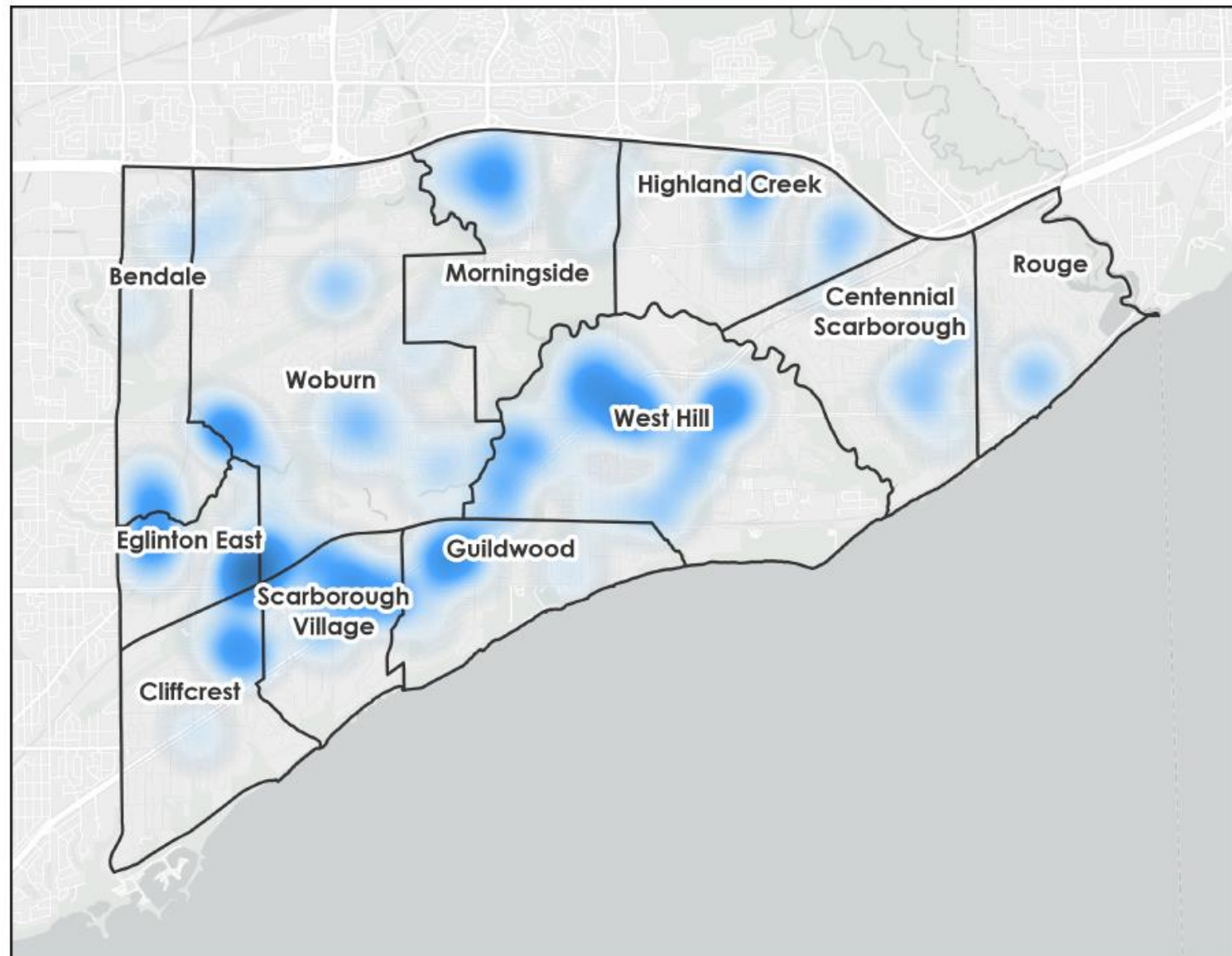

Theft from Motor Vehicle

- Vehicles continue to be targeted in driveways, residential parking lots, and commercial parking lots.
- There are several hotspots throughout the division. Major hotspots include; the area of Kingston Rd/Morningside Ave, the area of Military Tl/Neilson Rd, and the area of Eglinton Ave E.
- Catalytic Converters continue to be targeted, accounting for 8% of all theft from auto occurrences.
- 62% of occurrences did not report vehicle damage.

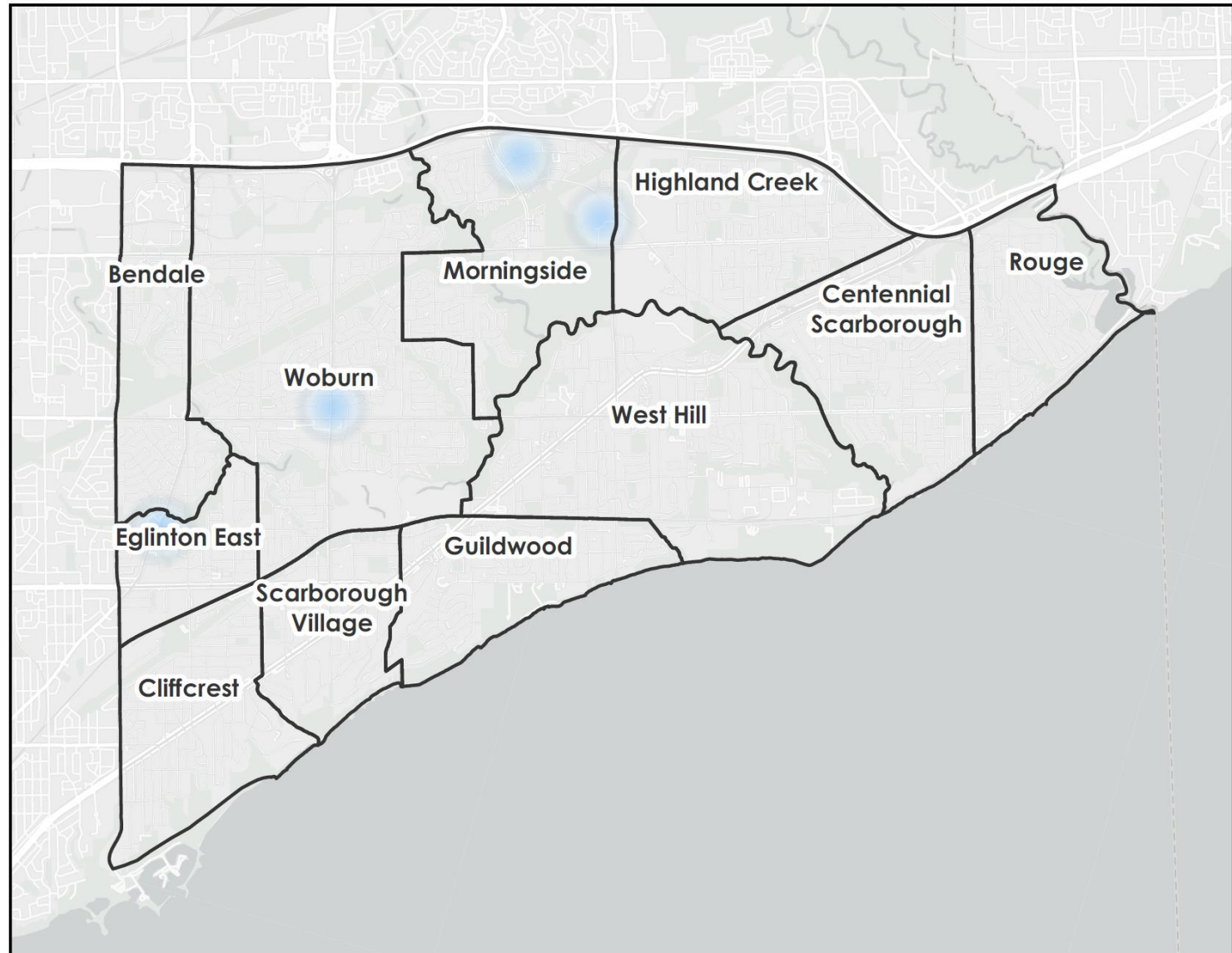
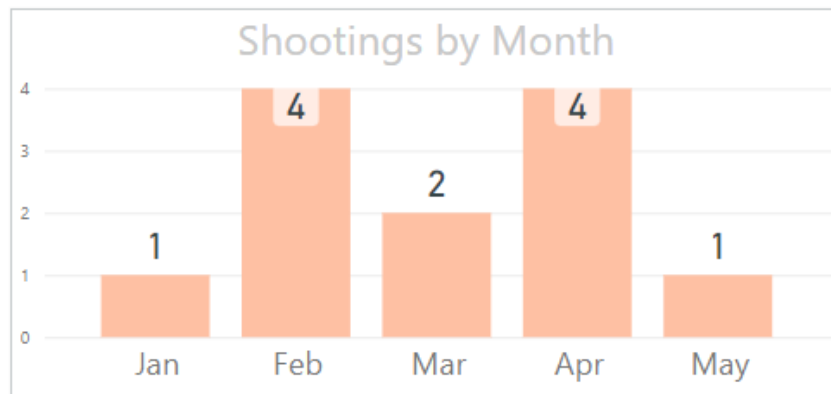
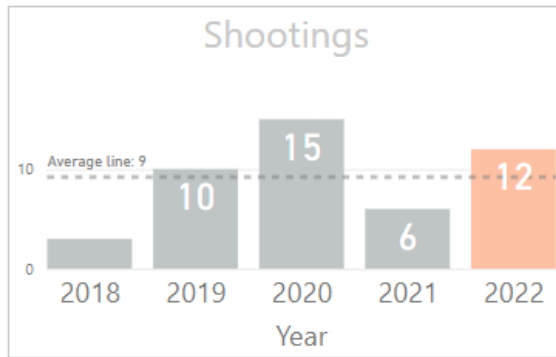

Firearm Discharges

- There was 4 occurrences in the month of April, which resulted in 5 injuries.
- Year-to-date, occurrences are located sporadically throughout the division, with a cluster in the area of Mornelle Crt and Ellesmere Rd between McCowan Rd and Bellamy Rd N.
- As of April 30, 2022, the year-to-date total was 83% greater than the 2021 year-to-date total.

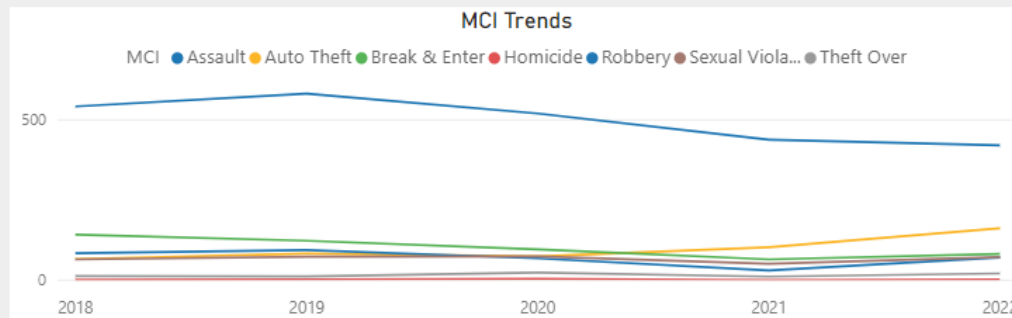
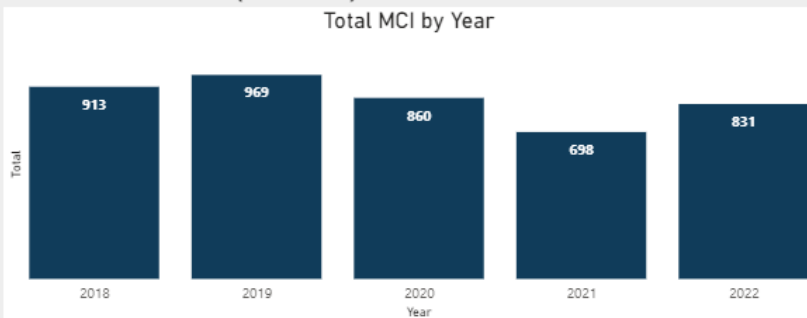

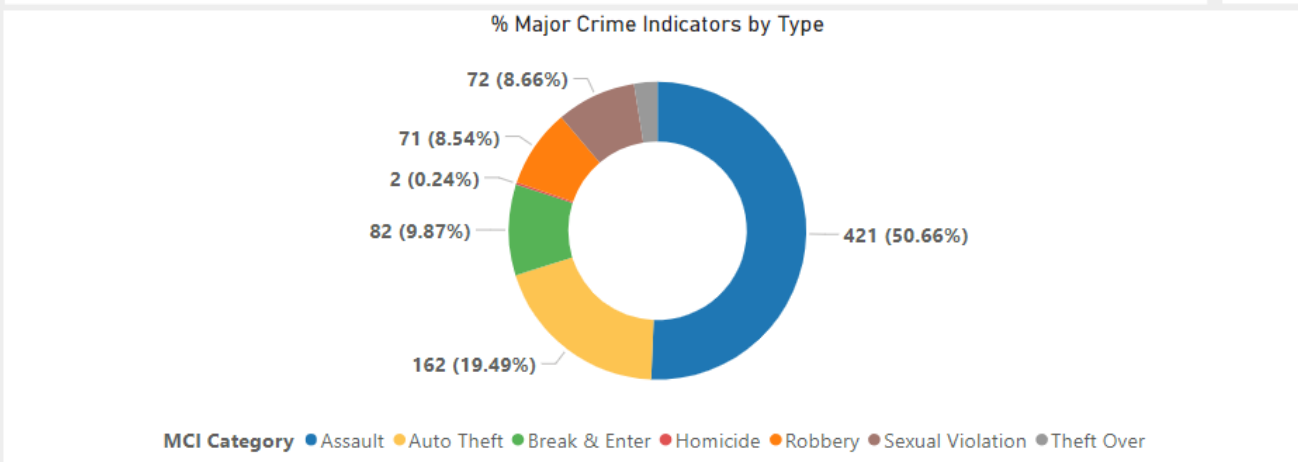
