Collisions

- There was 314 motor vehicle collisions during the month of May.
- Notable hotspots include; Kingston Rd/Lawrence Ave E, Lawrence Ave E/ Morningside Ave, Markham Rd/Ellesmere Rd, Eglinton Ave E, and the area of the Scarborough Town Centre.
- Collisions occurred most often between 12:00 and 17:00.



43 Division Collisions May 2023



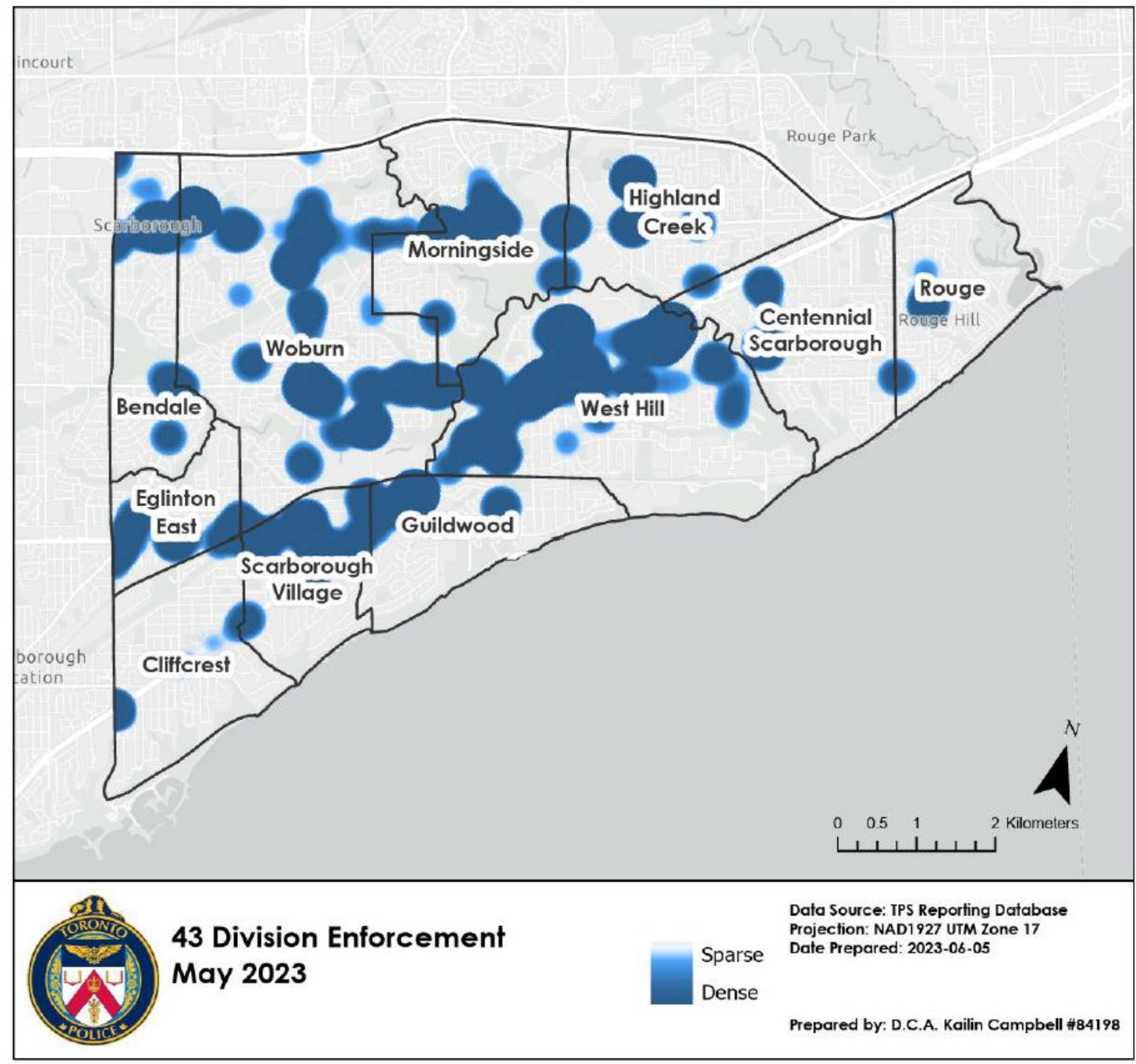

Enforcement

- There was notable enforcement along Lawrence Ave E, Markham Rd, Eglinton Ave E, Kingston Rd, Ellesmere Rd and the area of the Scarborough Town Centre.
- Enforcement was steady throughout the daytime and evening hours, with an increase during the morning rush hour (08:00 - 11:00).
- 50% of tickets were for Vision Zero offences (Speeding, Aggressive Driving, Distracted Driving).
- Traffic enforcement remains a priority as we move into the summer months.

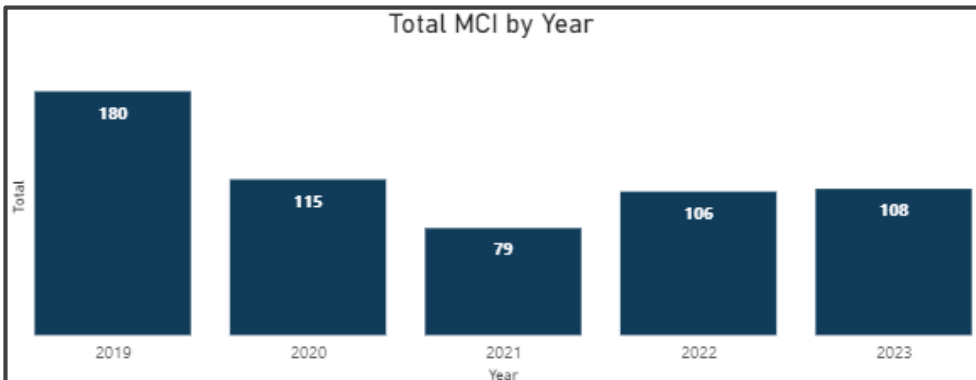

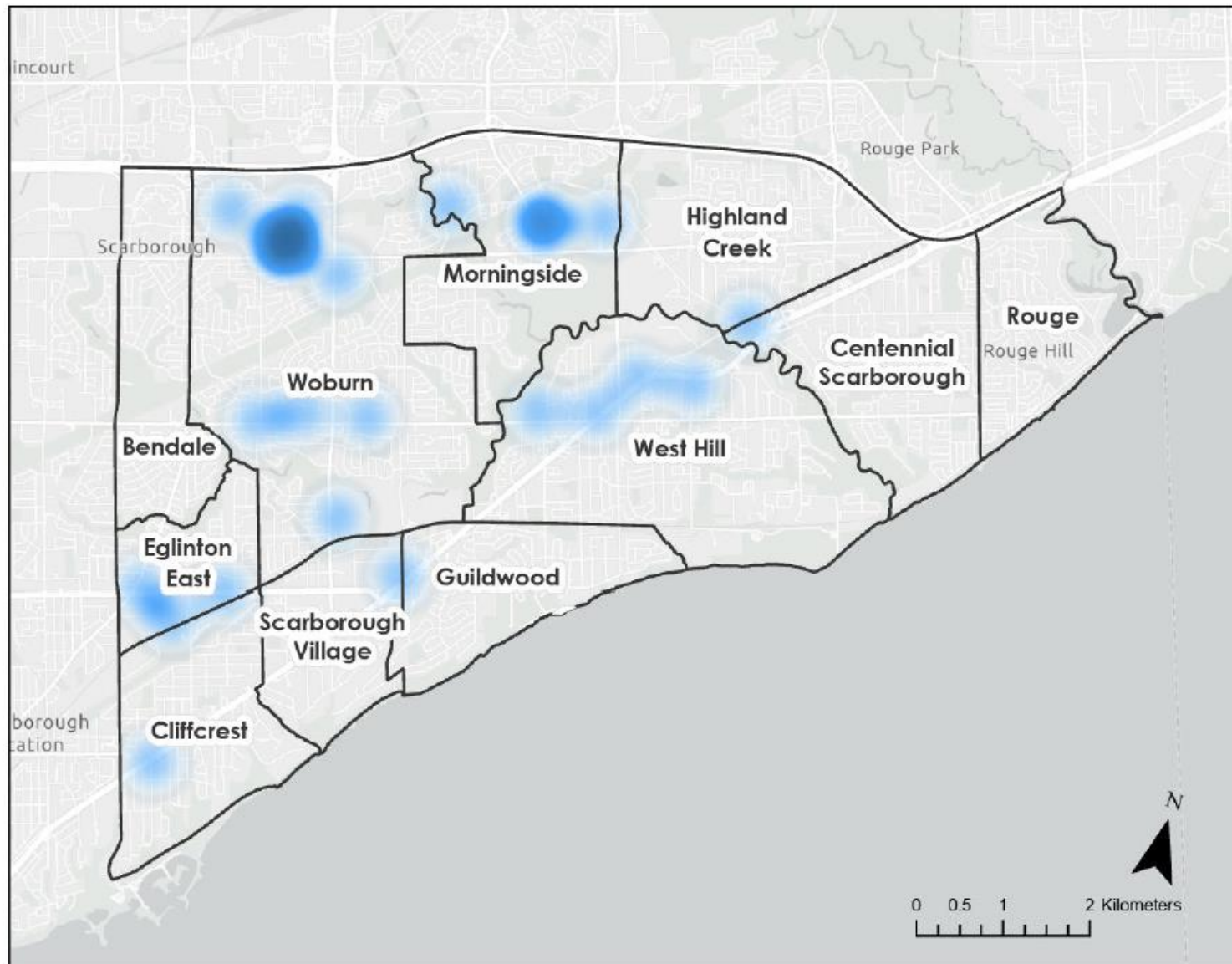
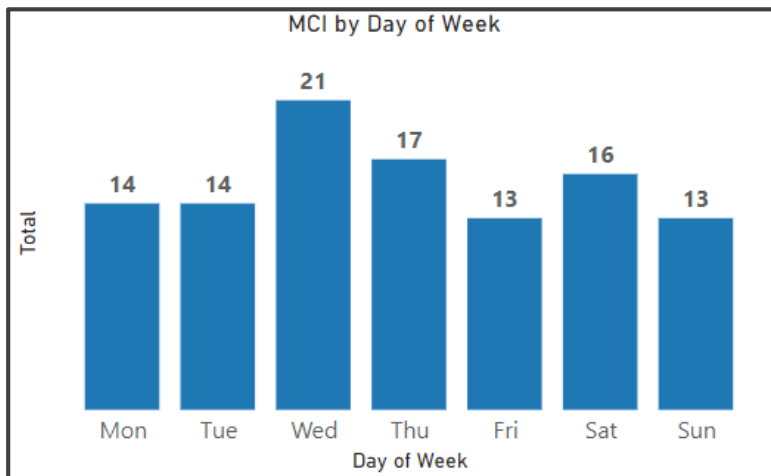
Break & Enters

- Break & Enters were located sporadically throughout the division, with several occurrences along Lawrence Ave E, Eglinton Ave E, Kingston Rd, and Progress Ave.
- 57% of entries were into commercial premises.

Auto Theft

- Occurrences were located sporadically throughout the division, with notable clusters at the Scarborough Town Centre, Markham Rd/Ellesmere Rd, and Kingston Rd/Meadowvale Ave.
- Newer model Toyota Highlanders, Lexus Rx350's, and Honda Cr-V's were targeted most heavily.
- There was an increase in motorcycle thefts, which is a seasonal trend that is typical for this time of year.



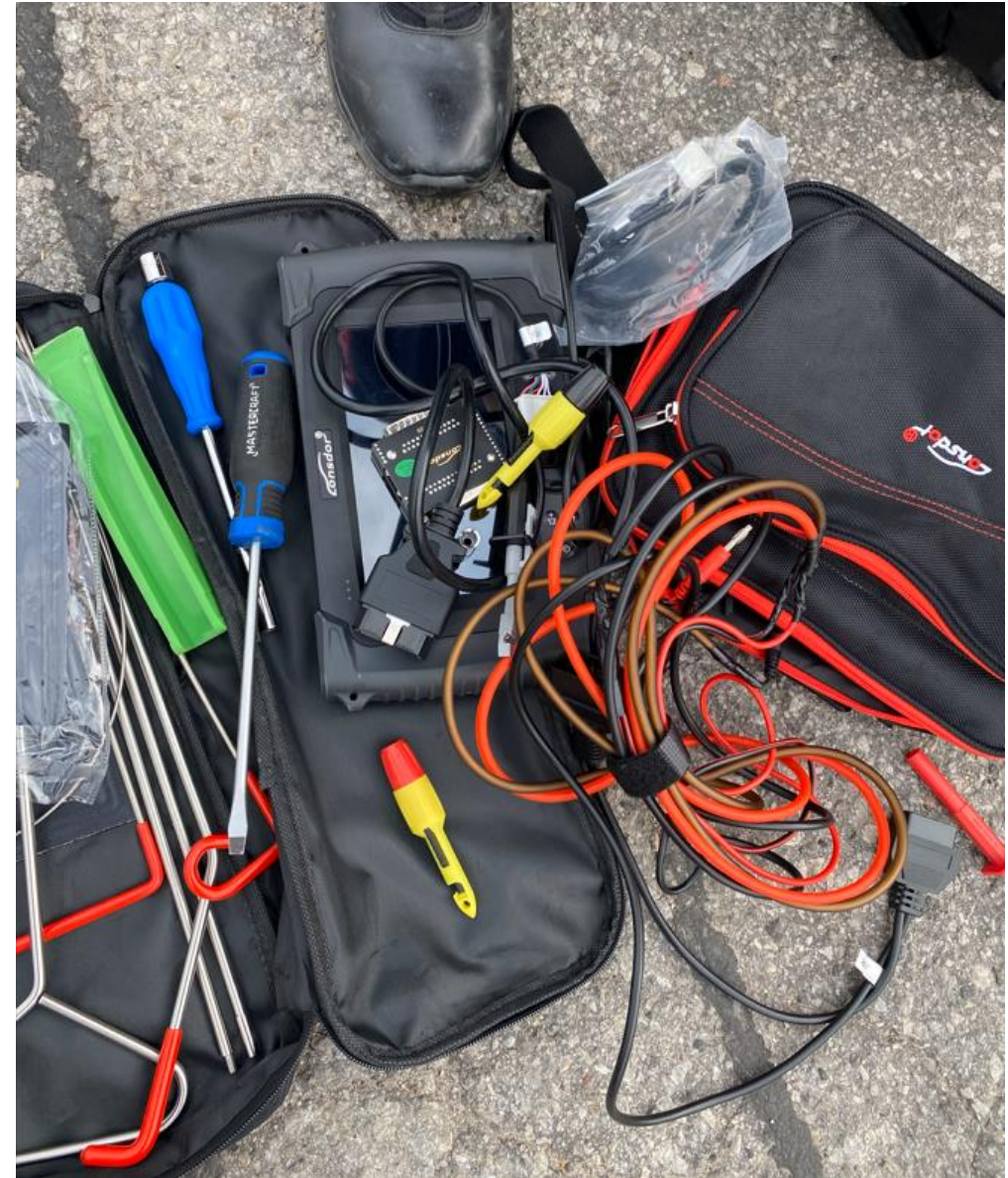
43 Division Auto Theft May 2023

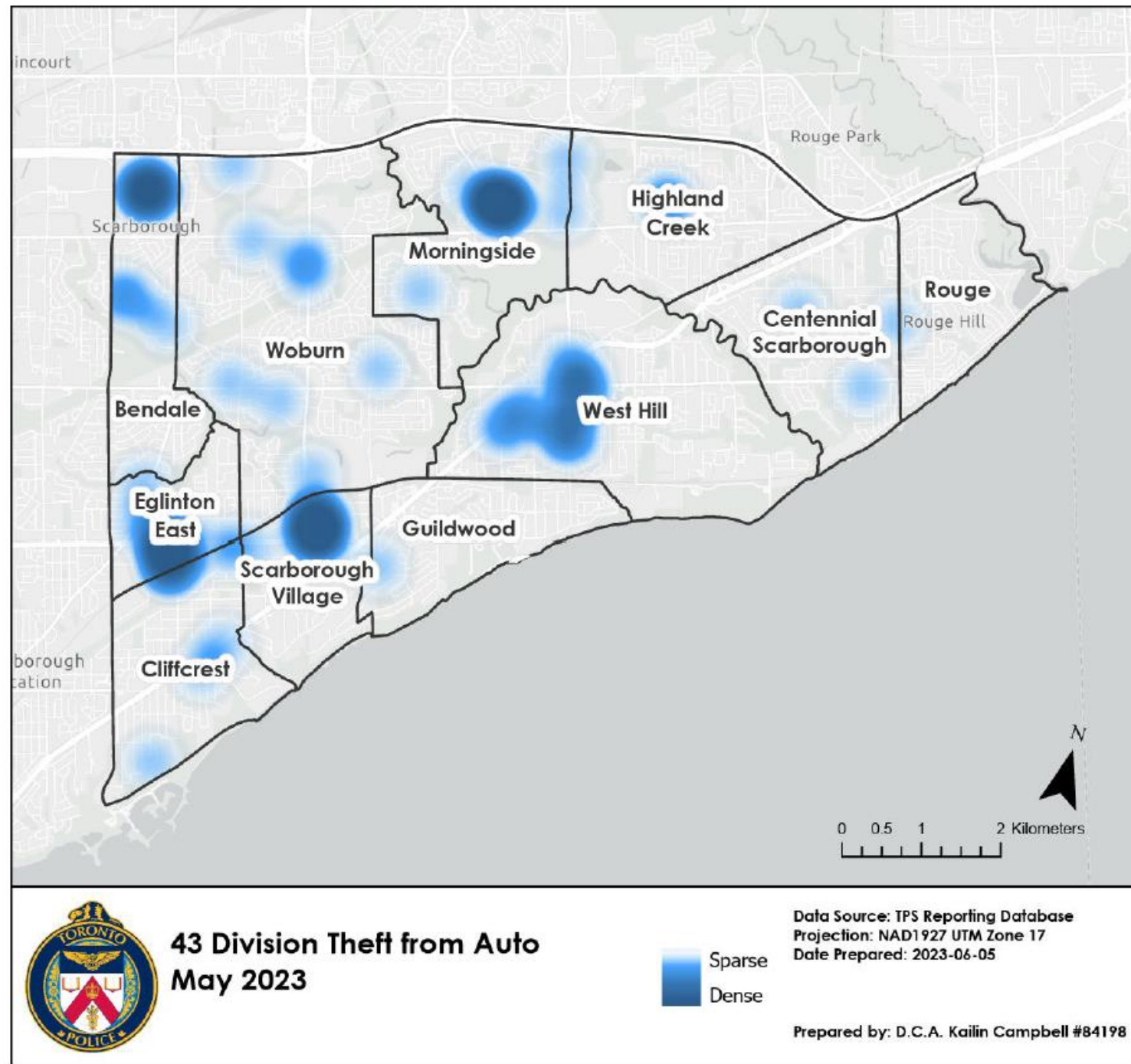

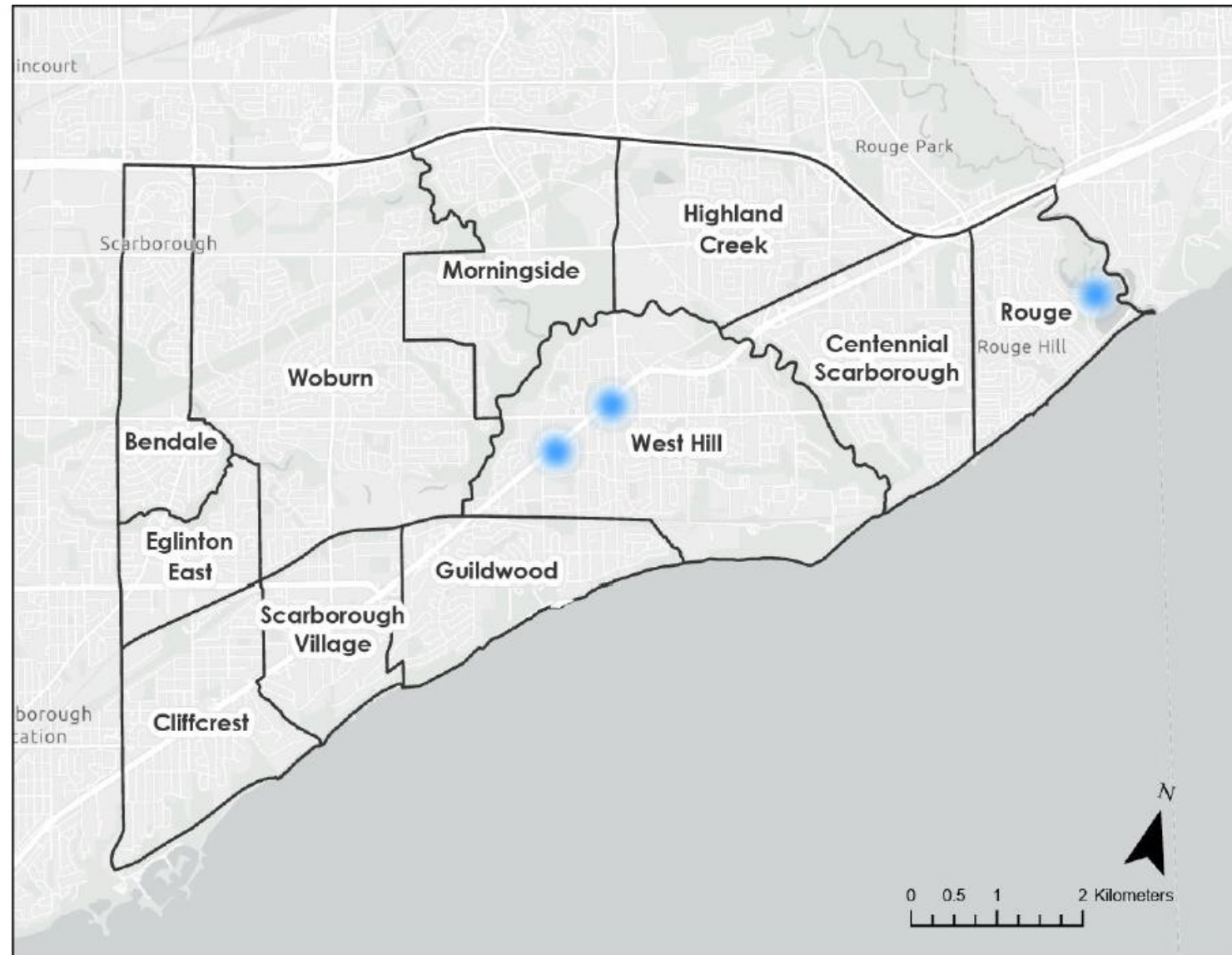
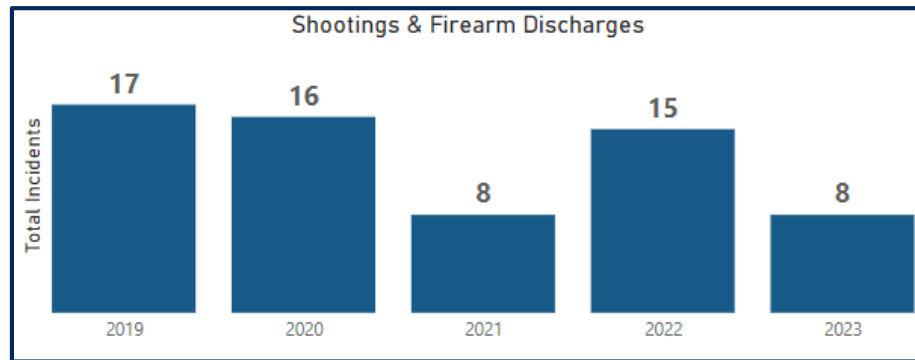
Theft from Auto

- Occurrences were located sporadically throughout the division, with significant clusters throughout Bendale, Morningside, West Hill, Eglinton East, and Scarborough Village,
- Vehicles were targeted in driveways, commercial parking lots, and residential parking garages.
- Of the occurrences where the vehicle was entered, 68% reported no damage.
- Wallets, loose change, sunglasses, and vehicle paperwork were stolen most frequently.
- There was a series of Catalytic Converter thefts along Eglinton Ave E. Nissan cargo vans were targeted most frequently.
- We continue to encourage residents to remove all valuable property from their vehicles, and to **never** leave their vehicles unlocked.
- We would also like to remind residents to never leave their windows open for airflow.



Firearm Discharges

- There was **three** firearm discharges within 43 Division throughout the month of May.
- Year-to-date, there has been a 46% decrease in firearm discharges compared to 2022.
